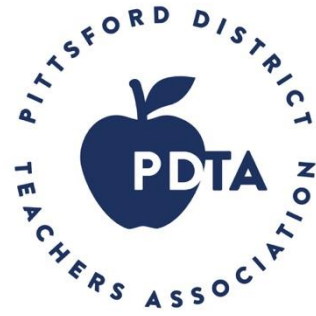


PDTA Extracurricular Committee Chair
